Delicate with gentle spicy toastiness, lemon and brioche. A caress of fine and elegant bubbles and a refreshing, long finish.

NV Colmant, Brut Rosé 12% Vol R 470 | R 80
Salmon pink colour, aromas of wild strawberry and redcurrant fruit followed by delicate floral notes, a subtle creamy texture and a persistent finish.

Light yeasty aromas, limey fresh fruit on the nose and rich creamy complexity on the palate.

2022 B.E.V., Sauvignon Blanc 13.4% Vol R 255 | R 60
Black Elephant Vintners 'Two Dogs, A Peacock & A Horse'. Aromas of passionfruit, lemongrass and grapefruit. Lively with refreshing acidity, minerality and a hint of creaminess

2021 Bosman Family Vineyards, Chardonnay 13.5% Vol R 490 | R 100
A medium oaked chardonnay with aromas of butterscotch, lemon curd and toasted brioche. Medium-bodied, balanced and refreshing with a creamy, long-lasting finish.

2021 Brookdale, Mason Road Chenin Blanc 13% Vol R 305 | R 65
Peach, pear and citrus aromas. Refreshing with vibrant acidity that is balanced by intense fruit concentration, a creamy round texture and a lingering aftertaste.

2022 Chamonix, Unwooded Chardonnay 12.5% Vol R 295 | R 60
Aromas of apples, lime, fresh herbs and tropical fruit. Steely dry with balance and zesty acidity that refreshes the palate.

2020 Nitida, Semillon 14% Vol R 385 | R 90
Aromas of fresh lemon and lime, cling peaches, jasmine and honeycomb. This wine is refreshing, intriguing and brilliantly food-friendly.

2019 Leeuwenkuil, Reserve White 13% Vol R 380 | R 75
Chenin Blanc-led, blended with Grenache Blanc, Marsanne, Verdelho, Clairette, Chardonnay, Colombar and Viognier. Aromas of white blossoms, apple and a hint of pepper. On the palate there is peach, pineapple and an underlying chalky minerality.

2020 La Residence, Rosemary Jane, Rosé **1500ml** 12%Vol R 420 | R 55
100% Shiraz. Bursting with aromas of ripe red apples, strawberries, redcurrants, fresh summer herbs and spring blossoms. Dry, refreshing and medium bodied with juicy acidity and an elegant creaminess.

2021 Oak Valley, Sounds Of Silence Pinot Noir 13.5%Vol R 470 | R 95
Pinot Noir. Cranberries, pomegranate, dried flowers and a deliciously savory earthiness that is so wonderfully typical of cool-climate Pinot Noir. Juicy, savory, elegant and concentrated.

2020 Boschklouf, Cab. Sauv. / Merlot 14%Vol R 260 | R 65
78% Cabernet Sauvignon and 22% Merlot. A full-bodied wine with ripe plum, chocolate and complex toasty oak. Concentrated with a long after-taste of blackberry, vanilla, fruit and spice.

2020 Natte Valleij, Cinsault 13%Vol R 420 | R 85
Perfumed and juicy with aromas of fresh redcurrants, cranberries, pomegranate, and baking spices. A light, yet concentrated wine elegant and approachable tannins.

2020 Lievland, Pinotage 13.5% Vol R 450 | R 115
A modern and elegant Pinotage with aromas of cherries and raspberries with cedar and vanilla from the oak. On the palate there is depth, concentration and richness from the addition of 14% Cinsault, Grenache, Mouvèdre and Syrah.

2019 Vondeling, Barrel Selection Merlot 13% Vol R 450 | R 90
Bursting with raspberry, black cherry and a subtle oyster shell salinity. The palate is fresh with red fruit, sweet liquorice, coriander seed and exceptionally fine tannin.

2017 La Residence, Nicole Alexandra **1500ml** 13.5%Vol R 420 | R 55
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. Aromas of ripe blackcurrants, wet earth, cedar wood and pencil shavings balanced by an enticing combination of smoked meat, pink peppercorn and cinnamon. Medium to full bodied with ripe and juicy fruit tannin, well integrated oak and a lengthy finish.

2013 La Residence, Shiraz **1500ml** 13%Vol R 440 | R 55
Aromas of fresh black berries and black cherries, toffee apples, dark cocoa powder, earth, tobacco and a myriad of intense and inviting pepper, ginger, cinnamon and vanilla spices. Smooth tannins with an elegant and persistent finish.

Blackcurrants and violets captivate on entry, followed by concentrated dark berry flavours and spicy tobacco oak.

2021 Nederburg Noble Late Harvest 10.8%Vol R 380 | R 55
Orange peel, apricot and dried peach aromas with a subtle balance between acid and sugar.

Western Cape

SHERRY

NV Douglas Green, Fino No.1 19% Vol | R 35
Produced from the Palomino grape. It has a fair, elegant, subtle sweetness with floral and nutty aromas and flavours. A pale gold traditional flor aged in wood and blended in the criadera and solera method.

Jerez-Xérèz

NV Monis, Pale Dry Sherry 18.5% Vol | R 20
This sherry's aromas show salt and citrus, ripe pear and nuts. On the mineral palate, are dry lime and cashew nuts that linger in a rich, dry finish.

Paarl

NV Monis, Medium Cream Sherry 18% Vol | R 25
Silky smooth with hint of sweetness and a nutty character. Butterscotch and pine needle on the nose and a long, silky flow across the palate with rich rather than sweet fine raisins, citrus and Christmas pudding flavours ending in a long finish.

NV Monis, Full Cream 18% Vol | R 25
Sweet vanilla with nuts and honey stand out in this balanced sherry. Also expect to find rich toffee and brown sugar with hints of barley sugar, spice and honey.

PORT-STYLE FORTIFIED WINE

2010 Boplaas, Cape Vintage Reserve 19% Vol R 720 | R 50
Bouquet slowly unfurls with ripe apricot, dried peach, a mélange of mulling spices, fynbos, intense plum, black hedgerow fruits and hints of liquorice. Cracked pepper combines with a lengthy finish with treacle, liquorice, fynbos and "meaty" notes. Unyielding tannins, intense spice and vibrant fruit structure – the hallmark of a Boplaas Cape Vintage Reserve.

Calitzdorp

NV De Krans, Cape Tawny 19% Vol R 720 | R 50
Beautiful orange sapphire in colour. Secondary aromas of orange peel, caramel, nuts and toffee that follow through with elegant, aged flavours of caramel, toffee, roasted nuts and fruitcake.

NV Pineau De Laborie 19%Vol R 360 | R 48
This fortified wine displays upfront aromas of rose petals, fresh cherries, plums and nougat. The intense concentration and good palate weight are well integrated with the light tannin structure.

METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE

NV Franschhoek Pass Winery, Morena 12.5% Vol R380
Brut Methode Cap Classique. A blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, aged for 2 years on the lees, this refreshing and balanced wine is dry, with crisp citrus flavours and just a hint of tropical fruit.

2020 Simonsig, Kaapse Vonkel 12% Vol R 480
An elegant Cap Classique with a light golden hue and fine persistent mousse. Fresh apple, white peach and citrus blossom entice on the nose. A refined palate shows bursts of lemon, stone fruits and raspberry with a hint of yeasty complexity. Beautiful acidity contributes extraordinary length and finesse to this Cap Classique.

2019 GM & Ahrens, Vintage III 12.5% Vol R 1 150
Fresh citrus and lots of minerality opens to a fuller texture of gunmetal and wet pepples finishing with the gentle warmth and fatness of Pinot Noir with a hint of red berries. One year in barrels gaining breadth and richness and 30 months lees maturation in bottle results a classically styled, elegant bubbly. Dosage is at the top end of “extra brut” resulting in a fresh, but dry bubbly that is classy.

2015 Peter Ferreira, Blanc de Blanc 12% Vol R 960
Taut, vibrant and youthful it's hard to credit 72 months sur lie on crown cap and a further 12 sur point on cork. Super-fine mousse, creamy texture, subtle brioche with a persistent finish. Chardonnay's lemon & lime, a mineral seam, bone-dry finish.

2015 Graham Beck, Blanc de Blanc 12.5%Vol R 740
Rich aromas of fresh lime and ripe apricot fruit on the nose. An exciting fine mousse with an explosion of tangerines on the palate. Great brioche and yeast complexity broaden the palate, leading to a long, elegant finish.

Robertson

2015 Dainty Bess 11% Vol R 595
Attractive salmon pink in colour. Raspberry fruit, light yeasty aromas followed by spice, red fruits, fynbos and herbs. Beautifully creamy, alive with bubbles and acidity that asks for food.

Wellington

2014 Creation, Elation 12.5% Vol R 710
An exquisitely crafted blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Classified ‘Brut Nature’, the wine contains only natural residual sugar and is delightfully crisp with an elegant touch of finesse with the gentlest aromas of lemon blossom and dried apple followed by wild strawberry and hints of fresh brioche.

2012 GM & Ahrens, Cuvée Agrandi 12%Vol R 8 500
Shimmeringly pale with a hint of lemon, yellow and green-gold tinge, the mousse is delicate and soft. Bubbles are persistent small little beads. Nose is refined, not richly yeasty as expected from more than four years on its lees, subtler, evolving slowly. Fresh aromas, zesty acidity followed by ripe peach, and a hint of lemon butter.

CHAMPAGNE BRUT

2013 Louis Roederer, Cristal 12% Vol R14 850

Produced uniquely during the best years, when the Chardonnay and Pinot noir grapes have attained perfect maturity. Cristal is aged for 6 years in Louis Roederer's cellars and left for a further 8 months after disgorgement. This concentrated, dense, ripe, fresh and long Champagne is unhesitatingly made using full-bodied, smooth Pinots and fresh, elegant mineral Chardonnays.

2010 Dom Perignon 12.5% Vol R 9 950

On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark & chiselled.

NV Deutz Classique 12% Vol R 2 790

Pale yellow-gold. Focused, expressive nose delivering lovely raspberry and citrus notes. The palate shows alluringly fine, closely integrated texture and bubbles, freshness, and persistency. A focussed, precise and elegantly dry Champagne.

Aÿ

NV Laurent-Perrier 12%Vol R 1 780

This fresh and pure wine is perfect for an apéritif. Its citrus and white fruits notes and its remarkable balance supported by a subtle effervescence, make it an ideal accompaniment to poultry and the finest fish.

Tours-sur-Marne

NV Moët & Chandon, Impérial 12%Vol R 1 850

Vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit with freshness of mineral nuances and white flowers and the elegance of blond notes like brioche, cereal and fresh nuts. On the palate it displays delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits like pear, peach, apple with nuances of gooseberry.

NV Taittinger, Brut Réserve 12%Vol R 1 930

Golden yellow in colour with elegant and fine bubbles. Expressive aromas of freshly baked brioche, peaches, white flowers and vanilla pod. The entry onto the palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony.

NV Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label 12%Vol R 1 960

Veuve Clicquot manages to reconcile two opposing factors - strength and silkiness - and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and freshness. This consistent power to please makes it ideal as an aperitif and perfect as the Champagne to enjoy with a meal.

CHAMPAGNE BRUT ROSÉ

2008 Dom Perignon 12.5%Vol R 12 180*

On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark and chiselled.

Hautvilliers

NV Billecart-Salmon 12%Vol R 3 830

Bright pale pink colour, with glints of gold. Delicate, slowly rising bubbles give it a persistent mousse. Subtle aromas leading to an elegant, delicate bouquet of fine notes of red fruits and citrus zest. A light, elegant flavour, followed by a fresh finish with a taste of raspberry. This rosé champagne is an ideal partner as an aperitif or lighter seafood dishes and berry desserts.

Mareuil-sur-Aÿ

NV Laurent-Perrier 12%Vol R 3 500

Elegant, with colour changing naturally from a raspberry hue to salmon pink. A precise nose of extraordinary freshness and a wide range of red fruits: raspberry, redcurrant, strawberry, black cherry. On the palate, it offers the sensation of plunging into a basket of freshly picked red berries.

Tours-sur-Marne

NV Moët & Chandon 12%Vol R 2 300

Pink with amber highlights and a lively, intense bouquet of red fruits - wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry. It's juicy, persistent intensity of berries with the fleshiness and firmness of peach and a subtle note of menthol.

Epernay

NV Taittinger 12%Vol R 2 430

Elegantly pink in colour. The bubbles are fine, and the mousse persistent. The full nose, wonderfully expressive, is both fresh and young and offers aromas of red fruits. On the palate, it strikes a fine balance of velvety texture and full body taste with flavours reminiscent of fresh, crisp red fruits.

2020 La Residence, Rosemary Jane, Rosé 12%Vol R 260

WHITE WINE

SAUVIGNON BLANC

2021 Ghost Corner, Wild Ferment Sauv. Blanc 13.5%Vol R 660
Naturally fermented Sauvignon Blanc. Enticing aromas of fleshy white pear and quince. Although this wine is dry, the fruit character gives an illusion of sweetness. Nine months barrel maturation gives a creamy, full palate with beautiful length and lovely concentration.

Elim

2021 Ghost Corner, Sauvignon Blanc 13.5%Vol R 530
A vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of lemon grass, white blossom, gooseberry and asparagus coming through. A wine showing great minerality and balance on palate with a creamy finish, loads of concentration and flavour that lingers.

Elim

2021 Springfield, Life from Stone 12.5% Vol R 370
The name derives from the rocky quartz soils in which it is grown. The vineyard battles against nature to produce concentrated wines flint, minerality and concentrated fresh fruit and herbs.

Robertson

2020 Ataraxia, Sauvignon Blanc 13.5%Vol R 340
It's style is individual and mineral ahead of pure and pungent fruit, yet still shows hints of passion fruit and citrus and green melon aromas. These are reflected on the palate and are complemented by a lively acidity, a classy structure and succulent texture.

Hemel & Aarde Ridge

2020 Waterford, Sauvignon Blanc 13%Vol R 320
A selection of Elgin's best quality vineyards. A very focused style showing fresh granadilla and green apple fruit with underlying chalk and slate notes. The palate is finely textured with crisp fruit, fresh natural acidity and a long finish of flavours.

2019 Cape Point Vineyards Sauv. Blanc 13% Vol *R 570
A complex array of orchids, white fruits, ripe nectarine, pink grapefruit and fig aromas. The palate is relatively lean yet intensely flavoured with racy acidity and a salty finish. Subtle hints of floral oak spice give the wine an extra layer of depth.

Cape Town

2019 Diemersdal 8 Rows Sauvignon Blanc 13.5% Vol R 530
Pronounced aromas on the nose that follows through on the palate. The wine shows a strong core of minerality with a flinty elegance on the nose with a rounded mouth-feel and balanced acidity on the finish. A seamless wine where all the components are in perfect balance.

Durbanville

2018 Klein Constantia Metis Sauvignon Blanc 14% Vol R 790
Bright and light in appearance with fresh citrus aromas. The wine has a round and expressive palate, full and grippy with a zesty acidity. It finishes with a long burst of mineral and lime flavours.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

2015 Driefontein, Single Vineyard 13.5%Vol R 560
A blanc fumé from the Stellenbosch area. An elegant nose of passion fruit and flowers with balanced minerality and fresh acidity. White peaches, ripe pears and a hint of pineapple and gooseberry on the palate.

2015 Reyneke, Reserve Sauvignon Blanc 13%Vol R 690
The nose presents a layered complexity and freshness of white stone fruit, pear and lime peel opening to a subtle floral prettiness. This wine has a textured minerality on the palate with a firm acidity and well-integrated oak component. A wine with lovely elegance and balance.

SEMILLON

2017 Boekenhoutskloof, Semillon 13.5%Vol R 640
Freshly squeezed citrus, pear, orange blossom, lemon curd and honeysuckle. The bright yellow fruit follows through onto a vibrant yet elegant palate with a richly textured mineral core, a firm structure and soft, balanced acidity. The wine has a long, dry, nutty, spicy finish with peach blossoms and hints of marzipan lingering in the mouth.

2017 Haut Espoir, Reserve Semillon 14%Vol R 390
This full-bodied wine has a light golden colour. The flavours and aromas have layers of dust and fynbos with Muscat tones, carrying through to a palate showing lanolin and honeycomb. The finish is long and elegant.

2017 Thorne & Daughters, Paper Kite, Semillon 12.5% Vol R 760
The wine is rich, textured and complex, showing wonderful spice, floral and savoury tones with great length including waxy lemon rind, sage, macadamia nuts and green melon.

2018 Rickety Bridge, Paulina's Reserve, Semillon 13% Vol R 580
2011 R 580
Lime and apple aromas layered with nuances of honeyed beeswax. The full, rich palate of honey and citrus is perfectly balanced with well-integrated oak notes, minerality and a delightful lingering creamy finish.

2021 Glenwood, Chardonnay 14%Vol R 600
Bold and powerful citrus burst, mouth-fillingly rich and creamy vanilla with beautifully integrated oak.

2021 Hamilton Russell Vineyards, Chardonnay 13% Vol R 1 560
A tight, minerally wine with classic Hamilton Russell Vineyards length and complexity. Unusually prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

Hemel & Aarde Valley

2021 Meerlust, Chardonnay 13%Vol R 875
Bright and polished with a complex, appealing nose of pear, citrus and floral notes developing into lemon cream, oatmeal and marzipan richness. Medium-bodied and linear but retains generous focused citrus fruit flavours with sleek, balanced and crisp acidity. The wine remains vivacious and fresh on the finish with clean citrus fruit and stony minerality.

2020 Ataraxia, Chardonnay 13%Vol R 880
A Burgundy-style mineral and very elegant Chardonnay. A mineral acidity is beautifully balanced by a subtle yet compelling intensity of fruit. A classic length, creaminess and intriguing complexity defines this stylish, world class Chardonnay.

Hemel & Aarde Ridge

2020 Chamonix, Reserve Chardonnay 13%Vol R 870
It has a bright straw yellow colour with golden highlights and exquisite aroma, with scents reminiscent of tropical fruit, ginger, spice and oatmeal. Well-structured and minerally with flavours of lime and toasted almonds on the palate.

Franschhoek

2020 Crystallum, The Agnes, Chardonnay 13.5%Vol R 820
A complex nose bursts forward with layered notes of ripe apple, pear and granadilla. The delightful fruity character of the wine is underpinned by a vibrantly zesty undercurrent of lime with nuanced notes of honey. The Agnes Chardonnay is a lovely example of an elegantly balanced cooler-region Chardonnay.

Overberg

2020 Rupert & Rothschild, Baronesse Nadine 13% Vol R 640
Lively aromas of peach blossom, lemon, gooseberry and mango supported by nuances of delicate nougat and lightly toasted macadamia nuts. Fresh acidity with a lingering soft textured palate.

2020 Creation, The Art of Chardonnay 13.5%Vol R 1 450
2019* 13.5%Vol R 1 450
2018* 13.5%Vol R 1 450

Grown in a single vineyard, this wine has a presence of its own. Vibrant aromas of fresh grapefruit and fragrant apple mingle with a hint of honey and a sprinkling of cinnamon. These are echoed on the palate where buttery nuances are balanced by the characteristic Creation minerality as a hallmark of freshness and finesse.

CHARDONNAY

2019 Paserene, Chardonnay 14%Vol R 1 950
The aromas combine great richness and elegance with abundant lemon zest, white peach, oatmeal and citrus blossoms. The mouth-feel is broad and luxurious with incredible length and vibrancy. **Elgin**

2019 Restless River, Ava Marie, Chardonnay 13% Vol R 1 050
2018 13% Vol R 1 050
2015* 13% Vol R 1 050
Exotic, fragrant nose on this expressive wine. Shows salted caramel, lemon butter, toffee apple and hazelnut complexity. The palate does not disappoint either with intense citrus fruits, creme brûlée, and a nutty chalky, mineral complexity.

2017 Kershaw, Deconstructed, Chardonnay 14% Vol R 3 170
Groenland Bokkeveld Shales CY 548
Sourced from the foothills of the Groenland Mountain in Northern Elgin, this clone has been taken from Corton Charlemagne cuttings. It produces wines that have aromatics oscillating between lemon blossom, white flowers, petrichor and struck stone. Full in body, they exude concentration with white stone fruit yet reinforced with an austere texture and robustness. Only 350 bottles produced.

Elgin

2017 Leeu Passant, Stellenbosch, Chardonnay 13.5% Vol R 1 810
Delicately floral nose with hints of nutmeg and cloves. The palate has a fresh acidity with notes of limes and lemon, some saline minerality and a beautiful oak character. The finish is long with great purity.

Stellenbosch

2017 Rustenburg, Five Soldiers 13.5%Vol R 1 140
Characters of ripe citrus, melon and peach with great minerality, rounded out by well-judged oaking. A very complex wine with a long and creamy finish and a good acid backbone.

Stellenbosch

2016 De Wetshof, Bateleur 13.5% Vol R 1 390
Named after an eagle that is rare in both its beauty and occurrence. This single-vineyard Chardonnay portrays a spectrum of flavours framed in elegance and complexity. Citrus and pear-drop notes are complemented by oak, nuttiness, concentration and intensity.

2015 Bouchard Père et Fils, Bourgogne La Vignée 14% Vol R 720
A regional Chardonnay from this producer. Aromatically inviting with a balanced roundness, and a silky, charming fruitiness. Lightly wooded, balanced and refreshing.

CHENIN BLANC

2021 Cederberg, 5 Generations 14% Vol R 850
Delicate aromas of honey, lime zest, roasted nuts and peaches laced with sweet vanilla undertones. Well-integrated wood and ageing on the lees developed a full, rich palate with a smooth lingering finish.

2021 Olifantsberg, Lark 13.5% Vol R 760
An old vine Chenin Blanc showing a balance of fresh stone fruit and bright citrus notes with a fleshy textured palate and length. An elegant, concentrated and refined expression of Breedekloof terroir.

Breedekloof

2020 Beaumont, Hope Marguerite 13%Vol R 1 100
Only native yeast, this barrel-fermented and matured Chenin Blanc is always elegant and complex. No Malo lactic fermentation was done to preserve the natural acidity and freshness of the wine. It spent 10 months on its gross lees and then bottled. It is seen as one of South Africa's benchmark Chenin wines.

2020 Ken Forrester, FMC 13.5%Vol R 1 865
